

- 4. Functional Adjustments (Manual Operation)
- A. Backrest Elevation (0° to 75°)





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- Use the right-side crank.

- Turn clockwise to raise, counterclockwise to lower. B. Leg Section Elevation (0° to 45°) - Use the middle crank. - Turn clockwise to raise, counterclockwise to lower. C. Side Tilting (0° to 45°) - Use the left-side crank. - Enables gentle lateral tilt for patient repositioning. D. Chair Position Adjustment - Coordinate backrest and leg elevation to form chair shape. - Ideal for eating, reading, therapy, or rest. 5. Commode Usage - Slide the integrated bedpan into the commode opening. - After use, pull out and clean with mild disinfectant. - Always reinsert securely. 6. Safety Guidelines - Ensure castors are locked during patient use. - Do not exceed weight limit.

- Confirm all cranks are turned gently and stopped when resistance is felt.

- Use guardrails at all times to prevent accidental falls.

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7. Cleaning & Maintenance

- Clean frame weekly with a damp cloth and mild soap.
- Disinfect mattress cover, tray, and bedpan regularly.
- Lubricate crank joints every 3 months.
- Check for loose screws or damaged parts periodically.

- Covers mechanical defects and operational issues under normal use.
- Free repair or replacement within warranty terms.
